

Volunteer role description Conservation volunteer

What is a research volunteer?

Conservation volunteers help Folkestone Museum care for its collections so they are kept in an excellent state of preservation to be enjoyed by this and future generations.

They are responsible for important conservation requirements including:

- monitoring relative humidity and temperature in the galleries and museum stores
- checking light levels
- checking for bugs
- completing object condition checks
- compiling conservation priority lists
- creating conservation records
- packing of objects in appropriate acid-free archival materials
- simple cleaning of objects
- explaining the important role of conservation at museum events
- assisting professional conservators working on artefacts at the museum
- supervising the public in basic cleaning of objects at 'conservation in action' events
- the safe movement of artefacts inside and outside the museum

Volunteers will be based at Folkestone Museum, supervised by the Curator and members of the museum team.
